Age group: 15 months – turning 3 during the school year

7:00 – 8:00 AM	Before School Care with Continental Breakfast offered in PP3 classroom with Free Choice Activities
8:00 – 9:55 AM	Individual Free Choice Activities with block play, dramatic play, music, science, math, language, manipulatives, puzzles, art, fine motor/practical life, books, and sensorial activities
9:55 – 10:15 AM	Hand washing and group snack time Diapering checks and changes
10:15 – 11:15 AM	Outdoor Time* or indoor movement and continued free choice activity time with free choice activities <i>*Weather and schedule permitting</i>
10:45 – 11:15 AM	Specialist Time or Indoor/Outdoor Movement Time with Free Choice Activities <i>*Depending on day of the week</i>
11:15 – 11:45 AM	Diapering checks and changes Continue Individual Free Choice Activities
11:45 PM – 12:00 PM	Closing Circle / Large Group Lesson/ Story time
Noon	Dismissal for half-day students
12:00 – 12:30 PM	Lunch time
12:30 – 2:15	Naptime / Quiet Time Students are offered snacks upon waking up
2:15 - 2:30 PM	Diapering checks and changes
2:30 – 3:00 PM	Outdoor time* or free choice activities <i>*Weather and schedule permitting</i>
3:00 PM	Dismissal for full day students Transition to After School Group for students who stay
3:00 – 3:30 PM	Outdoor time* with free choice activities or Indoor movement time, dancing, exercise, continue with free choice activities on shelves <i>*Weather and schedule permitting</i>
3:30 – 6:00 PM	Diapering checks and changes before pick up Free Choice Activities on shelves with after school care projects, music, stories, and art additionally offered Snack offered (4:45 – 5 PM)

- **Morning specialists' (music, yoga, Spanish) schedules and programs shift each year. Children not enrolled on days of specialists are invited to attend during their class specialist's time. Check with your teacher or the school office if you are planning to attend.**

Outdoor Weather Policy: Children will play outdoors daily as listed above when there is no active precipitation and when weather and air quality conditions do not pose a significant health risk to children as identified by the National Weather Service. Children's House has access to NOAA weather radio announcements and will check and verify through the National Weather Service website about conditions in our zip code area if weather conditions warrant. Please dress children appropriately.
